CEPT Means Scholarship

Type ofThis is a means based scholarship available to eligible students for the full duration of theScholarship:program subject to successful completion of each semester's full course work in first attempt.

Eligibility: Students with family income less than Rs. 10 lacs per annum are eligible to apply.
 This is a revised version of the existing scholarship and is open only to 1st year UG students in the B.Arch., B.I.D., B.C.T., and the B.U.D. programs admitted in 2016-17.

Annual Family Income	Eligible Scholarship Amount
Less than or equal to Rs. 3.5 lacs	90% of fees paid
Greater than Rs. 3.5 lacs and less than or equal to Rs. 5 lacs	70% of fees paid
Greater than Rs. 5 lacs and less than or equal to Rs. 7.5 lacs	50% of fees paid
Greater than Rs. 7.5 lacs and less than or equal to Rs. 10 lacs	30% of fees paid

Disbursement:

- **1.** All eligible applicants will be placed on a priority list in an ascending order of family income (lowest income first).
 - In case of more than one student having the same income level, their rank in the admission merit list will be used as 1st tie breaker and their percentage score in qualifying board exam will be used as 2nd tie breaker.
 - 3. First person on the priority list will be offered scholarship in the first slab; then the second person and so on, until the number of scholarships in that slab are exhausted. The next person on the priority list will be offered scholarship in the next available slab, and so on, until all slabs / scholarships are exhausted.
 - 4. If any scholarship budget is left over, it will be utilized either in the same year for other student scholarship or will be carried over as emergency scholarship fund, as decided by the scholarship committee.

President Scholarship

Type of This is a merit-based scholarship available to eligible students.

Scholarship:

Eligibility:This is a revised version of the existing scholarship and is open only to 1st year UG students in the
B.Arch., B.I.D., B.C.T., and the B.U.D. programs admitted in 2016-17.

Eligibility is based on Merit.

Merit rank based on CGPA / rank in admission merit list	Eligible Scholarship Amount
Highest merit rank	70% of fees paid
Second highest merit rank	50% of fees paid

Disbursement:

- 1. All eligible applicants will be placed on a program-wise priority list in a descending order of Admission merit Rank (or CGPA during renewal).
- 2. First person on the priority list will be offered scholarship in the first slab; then the second person and so on, until the number of scholarships in that slab are exhausted. The next person on the priority list will be offered scholarship in the next available slab, and so on, until all slabs / scholarships are exhausted.
- 3. If any scholarship budget is left over, it will be utilized either in the same year for other student scholarship or will be carried over as emergency scholarship fund, as decided by the scholarship committee.

Renewal:

1. Students need to reapply each year for renewal of scholarship.

- 2. Renewal is subject to their merit rank (based on CGPA) at the end of previous semester.
- 3. In case of more than one student having the same CGPA, their average SGPA of the immediate past 2 semesters will be used as 1st tie breaker and their average SGPA of the immediate past semester will be used as 2nd tie breaker.

Suspension / Withdrawal:

- Failure to complete full coursework (min 19 credits per semester) in past 2 semesters will lead to non-renewal of scholarship.
 - 2. The scholarship will be withdrawn in case a serious disciplinary or plagiarism charge is proved against the beneficiary student.

Notes:

1. All candidates receiving the above scholarships will also receive Rs. 5000/- annually in addition to the scholarship amount towards education expenses.

2. In addition to the above, other scholarships available through CEPT include a Bank Loan subsidy (upto 50% of the interest paid) and Student Assistantships (job-based scholarship). Details of the same will be announced shortly.

2. All eligible students are encouraged to apply for relevant scholarships offered by state and central government (including SC scholarship, ST scholarship, scholarship for disabled students, SEBC scholarship, Mukhyamantri Yuva Swavalamban Yojana, and National Minorities scholarship).

3. Students may apply for scholarships offered by the Government or other outside sources, which needs to be declared at the time of applying for CEPT scholarships. In the event where students have received financial aid from government / other scholarships, the scholarship amount disbursed by CEPT will be the difference between the CEPT Scholarship Amount and the amount received from Government or other sources.
