FULL TUITION SCHOLARSHIP

AVIATION MAINTENANCE (ENGINEER) TECHNICIAN

In Partnership with the U.S. – India Aviation Cooperation Program.

The Aviation Maintenance Technician program at Aviation Institute of Maintenance provides students with the knowledge, hands-on skills, and certifications required to become an FAA-certified Airframe and Powerplant Technician. Students are trained to service, repair, and overhaul aircraft components and systems, including the airframe, piston engines, turbine engines, electrical systems, hydraulic systems, propellers, instrumentation, warning and environment systems, and other systems in contemporary aircraft.

The Aviation Maintenance Technician Scholarship will be awarded to one student from India to cover the tuition costs of their AMT program within the campus near Norfolk, Virginia in 2018. The scholarship includes the full cost of tuition, certification exam preparation, and FAA-certification exam fees. (Fees associated with travel, room and board, visa and travel eligibility, and admissions fees are not included with the scholarship.) The estimated value of the scholarship is \$48,725 USD.

Applicants must have completed the equivalent of a high school diploma, be fluent in English, complete the Scholarship Application, and return it to AIM no later than May 31, 2017. Each applicant will be evaluated on an individual basis in relation to academic promise, passion for the aviation maintenance industry, and occupational goals within the aviation field. (The recipient will not be determined on the basis of race, sex, or age). Only applicants who have submitted a complete application by the submission deadline will be considered.

The Scholarship recipient will be announced July 4, 2017 and may begin classes as soon as September 2017.
