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SELECTION PROCESS

• The selection process for the scholarship will comprise of an offline Test of MCQs.

The structure of the Examination is as follows:

- **NOTE:**All question will be printed in English & Hindi except English OR Hindi language section Candidate will have to attempt either English or Hindi language questions in last section. Candidate must mark his/her preference at the OMR for choice of English or Hindi language paper.
- **Penalty for Wrong Answers** For each wrong answer one fourth or 0.25 of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty. If a question is left blank, i.e. no answer is marked by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question.
- The details regarding the time, date and address of the venue of the test, document verification for the short listed eligible applicants would be put on website. No separate communication i.e. either by post or otherwise would be issued to the applicants. Other instructions, if any, in this regard would be displayed on the website. *Applicants are therefore advised to visit website at regular intervals.*

NOTE

Candidates are requested to *apply only Online* against this advertisement on the Online Application (OA) website http://www.medhavionline.org and NOT write to the Organization for Application forms. They are also requested to go through carefully the details and instructions published below as well as on the website http://www.medhavionline.org

AGE LIMIT:

Minimum age imit is 16 years and maximum 35 years. Relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST & 3years for OBC candidates.

CITIZENSHIP:

A Candidate must be either:

- (a) a citizen of India, or
- (b) a subject of Nepal, or
- (c) a subject of Bhutan, or

(d) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, or (e) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka or East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania(formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (b), (c), (d) and (e) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.

MINIMUM ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

A candidate must have passed matriculation (10th) or equivalent examination from a recognised board.

NOTE:

The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum and the mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for test. Large number of application will be restricted/filtered. i.e. Candidate with higher qualification may be called only.

APPLICATION FEE:

- (a) Candidates are required to pay a fee of Rs. 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred only) for General/OBC category candidate and Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) for SC/ST candidates.
- (b) Applications without the prescribed fee would not be considered and summarily rejected. No representation against such rejection would be entertained.

(c) FEE ONCE PAID SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE NOR CAN THE FEE BE HELD IN RESERVE FOR ANY OTHER EXAMINATION OR SELECTION.

AGE RELAXATION

- The age is relaxable for SC/ST candidates upto 5 years and upto 3 years for OBC candidates.
- SC/ST/OBC candidates have to produce a caste certificate in prescribed proforma to avail such relaxation.

AGE & TIME RELAXATION TO PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED (PH) PERSONS:

- Age relaxation of 5 years (category age relaxation is also applicable along with this relaxation) in upper age limit shall be allowed to persons suffering from (a) blindness or low vision, (b) hearing impairment and (c) locomotor disability or cerebral palsy.
- Relaxation of age limit would be permissible to such persons who have a minimum of 40% disability.
- Candidate must produce disability certificate from a competent authority at the time of examination to get extra time for the exam (for Visually Handicapped (VH), blindness or low vision candidates only).

HOW TO APPLY:

- Note: CANDIDATES ARE ADVISED TO FILL THEIR CORRECT AND ACTIVE E-MAIL ADDRESSES IN THE ONLINE APPLICATION AS ALL CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE MADE THROUGH E-MAIL ONLY. FURTHER SCHEDULE AND REQUIREMENTS WITH REGARD TO COPIES OF CERTIFCATES TO BE SUBMITTED IN RESPECT OF CLAIMS MADE IN THE ONLINE APPLICATION WILL BE E-MAILED IN DUE COURSE TO THE CANDIDATES IN THEIR REGISTERED E-MAIL ID OR WILL BE POSTED ON THE WEBSITE.
- 1. Candidates must apply online through the website http://www.medhavionline.org. Applications received through any other mode would not be accepted and summarily rejected.
- 2. After filling up the form candidate must upload his recent photograph (in .jpg/.jpeg format not exceeding 50Kb of size) and signature (in .jpg/.jpeg format not exceeding 50Kb of size).
- 3. After successfull upload of Photograph and signature candidate must submit fee online only.
- 4. Submit the form after fee deposit.
- 5. A registration ID will be sent to the E-mail of the candidate.
- 6 After submitting the Online Application (OA), the candidates are required to take out a print out of the finally submitted Online Application (OA).
- 7. Candidates are not required to submit to the Organization either by post or by hand the printouts of their online applications or any other document.
- 8. The candidates are advised to submit the Online Application well in advance without waiting for the closing date.

NOTE:

- MERE SELECTION OF EXAMINATION CENTRE DOES NOT ENTITLE A CANDIDATE TO ALOT HIM/HER THE CENTRE SELECTED BY HIM. Allocation of centers to the candidates depends on the number of candidates at centers, if the number of candidates is less at any centre, than the organization reserve the right to alot a different center to candidates.
- ORGANIZATION WILL BE THE FINAL AUTHORITY TO DECIDE REGARDING EVERY CONDITION OF THE EXAM.

- (a) On the basis of number obtained in General Knowledge/ General Studies section.
- (b) On the basis of number obtained in Quantitative Aptitude section.
- (c) On the basis of higher educational qualifications than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement
- (d) Candidate with no job/work.
- (e) Candidate of higher age will be preferred.
