## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) for J&K PMSSS Scholarship During Admission (Online Registration) for AY 2017-18

1) Who is eligible for J&K PMSSS Scholarship?

**Ans:** Eligibility criteria under the J&K PMSSS Scholarship scheme:

1	Domicile	Must be domicile of J&K.		
2	Education	Must have passed 10+2 examination from J&K Board or CBSE

2) I have passed 10+2 in Commerce stream, am I eligible for engineering?

**Ans:** No, but you are eligible for Commerce stream under General course approved by section 12(B) of U.G.C. Information is available at: http://www.aicte-india.org/JnKadmissions.php.

3) I have submitted my application, is documents verification at Facilitation Centre is necessary?

**Ans:** Yes, without documents verification at Facilitation Centre, student is not eligible for Scholarship. A list of Facilitation Centres are available in AICTE website.

4) Is attending counselling mandatory for eligible students for availing benefits under PMSSS?

Ans: Yes, **it is Mandatory** for all the students to attend counselling in General/Engineering/Medical stream, who wants to take admission his/her own or through centralised counselling for availing benefits under the scheme.

5) I have passed 10+2 in science stream, am I eligible for Medical course under?

Ans: Yes, there is no counselling for Medical Stream with Biology. However, the candidate who seeks admission in any of the courses in Medical Stream (MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, etc.) on his/her own merit within the sanctioned intake in any of the institutions recognized by the respective Regulatory Bodies & located outside the State of J&K is eligible to avail the benefit of scholarship under this scheme based on the merit at class 10+2 & after qualifying NEET examination. The number of seats available under the medical stream & documents are to be verified in any of the facilitation centres. They also need to attend counselling for marking attendance only and showing admission proof.

6) I wish to pursue my studies in IIT/NIT/Centrally funded Institutions programs/Courses on my own without participating in J&K PMSSS counselling Process 2017-18. Am I eligible for J&K PMSSS scholarship?

**Ans:** NO, any candidate who seeks admission in any of the IIT/NIT/Centrally funded programs/courses within the sanctioned intake located outside the State

of J&K on his/her own merit is eligible to avail the benefit of Scholarship under this scheme based on the merit at class 10+2 and number of seats available under General / Engineering Stream and having their documents verified in any of the facilitation centres. They also **need to attend counselling** for marking attendance and showing admission proof.

7) What is the J & K Scholarship amount for various streams?

**Ans:** The following types of fee will be reimbursed subject to maximum of ceiling:

8) I am an eligible candidate for J&K PMSSS scholarship. How can I apply for registration of this scholarship?

Ans: Log on to <a href="http://www.aicte-jk-scholarship-gov.in/">http://www.aicte-india.org/JnKadmissions.php</a> to apply for "Online Registration for scholarship" and follow the instructions on how to fill the online application.

- 9) Is Aadhaar card a mandatory document for J&K PMSSS scholarship?

  Ans: Aadhaar card is not mandatory during online registration.
- What format or size of photo and signature to upload in website for J&K PMSSS Scholarship?

Ans: Both photo & signature should be in JPG/JPEG format with Size <200kb for photo & <50 Kb for signature.

11) Is it necessary to submit separate online application for General & Engineering course?

**Ans:** Candidates are required to select "**Both**" option from the dropdown menu under "**Stream applied for**" field, if they want to apply for both General & Engineering Stream under J&K PMSSS while submitting online application.

12) I have filled & submitted my online application form. What should I do next?

**Ans:** Take printout of online filled application and visit your nearest facilitation centre along with original documents & one set of self attested photocopies (Xerox) of all original documents for document verification as or when the centres open.

13) I have submitted my online application for J&K PMSSS scholarship. Is it possible to edit my application?

**Ans:** Yes, Nodal Officer of facilitation centre can only edit subject to the production of original documents in support of your claim/request for editing.

14) To which facilitation centre should I go for document verification?

**Ans:** You can go to any one of the facilitation centres established by Govt. of J&K as per your convenience for document verification. (List of Facilitation Centres is available at <a href="http://www.aicte-india.org/jnkadmissions.php">http://www.aicte-india.org/jnkadmissions.php</a>)

15) Is there any document I should collect from facilitation centre after document verification process?

**Ans:** Yes, you must collect document verification report from the facilitation centre without fail. You are required to produce the document verification report during counselling.

16) Is it necessary for me to submit original documents to the facilitation centre after the document verification?

Ans: No original documents are to be submitted to the facilitation centres.
