Bharat Ratna Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya was a matchless personage in the annals of modern India. He was one of the topmost leaders of Indian politics to give expression, loud and clear, to the voice of the Indian people in provincial assembly and central council, the grandfather of Indian national congress who accelerated and brought to fruition the struggle for freedom, the exponent of the re-awakening of Indian culture and of swadeshi and Hindi movements, the great social reformer who saved millions of untouchables from conversion through a novel and revolutionary experiment of initiating them into holy mantras and bringing them into the mainstream of educational and social developments, a great patriot who strove lifelong to revive the Hindu way of life and bring about harmony between Hindus and Muslims. His foresight to visualise the need of advance scientific and technical education and his pioneering pro-active work to foster their growth, while upholding and preserving the ancient values of Indian culture and heritage through establishment of Banaras Hindu University, made outstanding contribution not only to the national struggle for political independence, but thereafter in the economic and social development of the country.

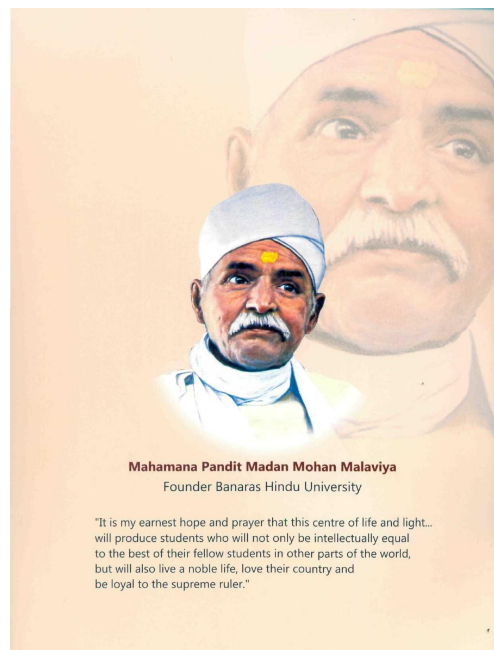

About Banaras Hindu University (BHU)

The Banaras Hindu University, founded by Bharat Ratna Mahamana Pt. Madan Mohan Malviya Ji in 1916 on the auspicious day of Vasant Panchmi, is one of the most prestigious central Universities in the country, and the largest residential university in Asia. A living embodiment of ideas and ideals of such visionaries as Mahamana Malviyaji, Dr. Annie Besant and Dr. S. About the Scholarship

As a mark of honour and glowing tribute to its Alma mater and legendary founder, BHU Alumni Association, Ranchi, takes a first decisive step to proudly announce the launching of Merit-cum-means scholarship called **MAHAMANA MALVIYA SCHOLARSHIP**. The scholarship aims to help poor and meritorious students to pursue higher education by mitigating their sufferings and economic hardship.

The scholarship shall be granted to the students of class XI & XII only. The selection for scholarship shall be based on the results of class X, 4 students (two boys & two girls) of class XI shall be selected for scholarship. From academic year 2014-15, 2 students each from class XI & XII shall be selected for the scholarship. Each student shall be given a maximum amount of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in an academic year along with a citation. The amount shall be given through Account payee cheque in the name of selected student.

The scholarship will be limited to students of CBSE schools of Ranchi Municipal area only.

Not more than 4 applications shortlisted by each school fulfilling the criteria should be sent to the BHU Alumni Association.

The last date for receipt of complete application in all respects in the office of Secretary, BHU Alumni Association shall be **20th January, 2016**.

The scholarship shall be awarded to the students on the BHU alumni association annual day function to be held on **20th February 2016**.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP

1. This scholarship shall be granted only to students studying in class XI & XII.
2. The scholarship will be granted to two boys and two girls.
3. Students securing greater than or equal to 60 % marks or CGPA 7 or B2 grade in all the subjects at the annual examination can only apply.
4. The income of the parents/legal guardian should not exceed Rs.100,000/- (Rupees One Lac only) per annum (both father's and mother's income taken together).
5. Students will not be eligible for the award of scholarship if he/she is receiving scholarships from any other source. The declaration in this regard, copy of the marks sheet and recent income certificate (to be obtained from appropriate Govt. Authority and signed by Principal of the school) must be submitted along with the application. The income certificate to be submitted, must not be more than 1 year old.
6. The students applying for scholarship must record at least 75 % attendance throughout the academic year. In this respect, an attendance certificate is required from the principal of the school.
7. The students should have good discipline and no adverse report regarding the conduct is pending against him/her.
8. Only one student will be granted the scholarship from a family in an academic year.
9. Once granted, the scholarship will be applicable for only one academic year which will be renewable after considering all the above mentioned conditions, for another 1 year. In any case, the scholarship will be granted for maximum period of 2 years. The academic year for all purposes, shall be taken as the financial year e.g. 2012-13 academic year shall mean period from 01.04.2012 to 31.03.2013.
