#### Scholarship eligibility criteria for a SEAS applicant

Program	Eligibility
B. Tech	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with a minimum 60% aggregate in PCM (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics).

#### Scholarship eligibility criteria for a SLABS applicant

Program	Eligibility
B.Sc (Computer Science)	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with an average of 60% marks.
B.Sc (Chemistry)	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate in Science with an average of 60% marks.
B.Sc (Biology)	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with Biology and an average of 60% marks.
B.Sc (Mathematics)	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with Mathematics and an average of 60% marks.
B.Sc (Physics)	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with Physics and Mathematics as subjects and an average of 60% marks.
B.Com	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with both Accountancy and Commerce and a minimum aggregate of 60%.
B.A. (English, History, Economics, Journalism)	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with an average of 60% marks.
B.B.A.	Higher Secondary (10+2) / Intermediate with an average of 60% marks.

#### Terms and conditions

- 1. The annual family income of the applicant should not exceed ₹ 4 lakh. An income certificate must be submitted by the student every year.
- 2. Maximum of one scholarship per student will be awarded.
- 3. The academic performance of a student shall be the sole criteria for continuation of the scholarship. Scholarships are subject to renewal
