1. The department of Education introduced the merit Scholarship in this Union Territory of Lakshadweep during the year 1984-85 onwards. The Merit Scholarship Exam (MSE) scheme also underwent a change in the year 2012-13. The scheme has been made open to the students of classes 6<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> and separate examinations where conducted for each class. This Scholarship exclusively meant for Scheduled Tribe Students of Lakshadweep.

#### 2. Important highlights in the Scheme:

- The students passing in the examinations with 60% marks and above will receive "Excellence" scholarship and 75% and above will receive "Outstanding" in middle elementary, secondary and senior secondary classes from the department.
- 2.2 The students qualified for the merit scholarship under this scheme will receive merit scholarship in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> classes at middle elementary level, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> classes at secondary level and 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> classes at senior secondary.
- 2.3 The rate of monthly scholarship under the scheme is revised and enhanced to Rs. 400/¬, Rs. 500/¬ and Rs.750/¬ for the students of middle elementary , secondary and senior secondary respectively, scoring average of 60% and above marks and Rs. 500/¬, Rs.650/¬ and Rs.1000/¬ respectively for the students scoring average of 75% and above in the merit examination.
- 2.4 The Merit scholarship awardees will continue to receive the normal school scholarship available to all the Schedule Tribe children of Lakshadweep sanctioned by the Department of Education .
- **3.** Eligibility criteria for appearing merit examination: There are three levels of examination for the students.
  - 1. All the Scheduled Tribe Students passed 5<sup>th</sup> Standard and secured 60% or above marks in the annual examination held in March 2017.
  - 2. All the Scheduled Tribe Students passed 8<sup>th</sup> Standard and secured 60% and above marks in the annual examination held in March 2017.
  - 3. All the Scheduled Tribe Students passed 10<sup>th</sup> Standard and secured 60% and above marks in the annual examination held in March 2017.
