You must be having many queries regarding the working of school. So, please go through the guidelines given below for students & parents to be followed in school.

### **Guidelines for Parents:**

1. All the selected students can come with their parents on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2019.
2. Orientation for parents (Localities +Outsiders) will be on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2019 from 2:30pm to 6:30 pm.
3. Following original documents need to be brought for verification at the time of finalisation of admission process. Attested copy of the same should be handed over to GDGIS.
  - a. Certified true copies of School Reports (written in English) of the last two years. (Attested copy of current class)
  - b. Certificates of Merit, If any.
  - c. Attested birth certificate (photocopy)
  - d. Character Certificate / Code of Conduct / Bonafide Certificate
  - e. Passport size Photos – Student (4), Parent (2)
  - f. Residential Address Proof (Parent / Guardian)
  - g. Aadhar Card (Student & Parent / Guardian)
  - h. Pan Card (Parent / Guardian)
  - i. Transfer Certificate Within 20 Days of Admission (Original)
  - j. Pre Board Exam Report / Class 9 Marks Card
  - k. Report Card of Board Exam after Board Result is declared (Month of June)
4. Please fill the admission form on the day of arrival and mention the type of food to be taken. (regular or Jain)
5. Selected scholar will receive the following things on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2019 :
  - a) Stationery, Uniform, Text book, Notebooks etc.
  - b) Dorm allotment to boarder would be on the same day (6<sup>th</sup> April 2019).
6. Parents must give their proper contact number and e-mail id to the school so that communication can happen smoothly.
7. School timing is 7:50 am – 12:50 pm. 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturdays are working days, timing for Saturday is 7:50 am – 2:00 pm.
8. Practical classes will be arranged accordingly.
9. Take a note of list of items to be carried by hostelites (Annexure-II) at the time of finalisation of admission process.

### **SCHOOL RULES**

(FOR STUDENTS)

- I. Every student should carry the Almanac to the School daily.
- II. Student who comes to school on their own should arrive at the School five minutes before the bell rings
- III. Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. The school uniform must be worn on all working days.
- IV. Girls should not apply nail polish or mehendi during school session. Nails to be trimmed at least once a week.
- V. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles to School. Girls can wear very small studs or ear rings in gold or silver.
- VI. Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones/ iPods/ camera's etc. into the school campus. These gadgets if found in possession of the student within the school campus will be confiscated.
- VII. The name, class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on the blazer and all other belongings of the student.
- VIII. Changing classrooms between periods when necessary should be done silently and in an orderly manner.
- IX. Shouting, loud talking or whistling is not allowed in school.
- X. Care must be taken for all school property and no student should scratch or spoil the desks or charts or damage any furniture, write or draw anything on the walls or damage things belonging to others. Damage done should be reported at once to class teacher or to the Vice Principal. Any damage done will have to be made good by parents of the student(s) concerned.
- XI. Each student should have 3 identity cards with his/her photograph. One has to be worn by the child daily and the others to be kept with the Parents (Mother/ Father) Those who are coming to pick up the Students from the school/bus stop must always bring the School Identity card for identification.



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- XII. Students are not allowed to use the school telephone without the permission of the Principal. They will not be called to answer phone during class hours.
- XIII. Parents are requested not to visit their wards in the classroom without the permission of the Principal/ Vice Principal. Communication with the teacher should be through the Almanacs on a regular basis, to monitor the performance of the student. Requests for meeting teachers on school days other than on PTM days will not be entertained, if necessary prior approval of the Principal/Vice Principal must be obtained.
- XIV. Appointment with Dentists/Doctors or others should be avoided during school hours. Such requests for early leave will not be entertained.
