NOTIFICATION

National Overseas Scholarship for Minority community students 2019-20

The state Government through the Directorate of Minorities has introduced a scheme for providing financial assistance (in the form of Scholarship) to Minority students of Karnataka State only for pursuing higher studies abroad in Master Degree. Ph.D and Post Doctoral Courses etc., in prestigious Foreign Universities.

Interested and eligible Minority Community students of Karnataka state Domicile can apply in the prescribed <u>application</u> <u>Online</u> by visiting Directorate of Minority Official Website www.gokdom.kar.nic.in.

Minority Students opting to pursue higher studies in the following subjects only can apply and get benefit of **Scholarship** through Directorate of Minorities, Bangalore.

Subjects:-

1) Automation Robotics including Artificial Intelligence, Mechatronics and Manufacturing Technology. 2) Laser Technology 3) Paper technology 4) Naval Architecture/Offshore Structures/Architecture in General. 5) Information Technology including Computer Engineering Software, software Quality Assurance, Networking /Connectivity Engineering, Communication system, under hazardous or Post - Disaster conditions, Multimedia communication 6) Low temperature Thermal Dynamics 7)Optometry8) Art Restoration technology 9) Ceramic and Glass Technology 10) Dock and Harbour Engineering 11) Bio-Technology/ Genetic Engineering 12) Industrial Safety 13) Petroleum Technology 14) Aircraft/ Space Engineering 15) Imaging System Technology 16) Graphic engineering 17) Composite materials engineering including Decentralized Power, Distribution (for Solar Heat) System, Energy Storage Engineering, Energy conservation, Energy efficient habitat Engineering, 18) Satellite or remote Sensing 19) Packaging Engineering/ Technology 20) Nuclear Engineering 21) Medicine / Dental / Nursing/ Para- Medical 22) Business Administration/ Management Studies 23) MPhil/Ph.d in any area of applied Sciences., Basic Sciences, Cultural and Historical Studies.

In addition to these subjects any other course/Subjects the Selection committee of the department may in special cases consider the course for scholarship not listed above.

Eligibility Conditions:

- 1. <u>For Post Doctoral</u>:-Candidates should have scored 60% and above marks or equivalent grade in relevant Master Degree.
- 2. <u>For Ph.d</u>:- Candidates should have scored 60% and above marks or equivalent grade in relevant Master Degree.
- 3. <u>For Master Degree</u>:-Candidates should have scored 60% and above marks or equivalent grade in relevant Bachelor Degree.
- 4. The student must be a domicile of Karnataka.

Non eligibility Conditions:-

- 1. Post Degree Diploma course, Trainings, certificate course, Integrated course, crash courses, correspondence course
- 2. 2nd term Master's Degree course
- 3. Students who have already availed this benefit from Minority Department Previously
- 4. Students belonging to other states
- 5. Students from other communities other than Minority Communities
- 6. Students scoring less than 60% of Marks in their Degree Exam
- 7. Students already done their Master's Degrees in any other Subject
- 8. Incomplete Offer Letter from Foreign Universities (not furnishing Correct Course details, Fees information, living expenses, duration of course Etc...)
- 9. 2nd child of the same family not eligible to apply
- 10. Exceeding Income Limit of 15 Lakhs per annum
- 11. Students already done their Master's degree are opting for Master's Degree again
- 12. Students not scanning the required documents at the time of Online application

Age Limit:-

The student must be below 38 years from the date of commencement of the opted course or subjects selected for higher Studies.

Financial Assistance & Income limit:-

A maximum Scholarship of Rs.10.00 lakh per annum and a maximum of Rs.20.00 lakh (for 2 years) for the entire course will be sanctioned to the candidates whose total Family income from all sources (of the candidate and his/her parents/Guardians) should not exceed Rs.6.00 lakhs per annum & for those students whose total family income from all sources is between Rs. 6.00 lakhs per annum to Rs 15.00 Lakhs per annum, are eligible for 50% of the Scholarship subject to a maximum of Rs. 5.00 lakhs per annum (for 2 years). The Sanctioned amount covers the tuition Fee, Living expenses, and one side Airfare as has been prescribed for all levels of courses covered under the scheme.

Mandatory Conditions:-

The candidates shall obtain the required Offer letter from the Foreign University prior to the application made to the Directorate of Minorities, Bangalore-01. The candidates are required to seek admission and join regular courses/Full time courses in accredited Universities/ Institution only.

Default under the scheme:-

The selected candidates have to execute a bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.200/- as required under this scheme, in the prescribed format. In case a candidate pursuing studies abroad violates any of the terms and conditions of bond executed by him/her such candidates will be liable to pay the entire amount along with 12% interest per annum to the Government.

Mode of selection:-

- 1. The candidates after assessing their eligibility and suitability and as per conditions of the scheme shall apply to The Director, Directorate of Minorities, 21st Floor, V.V.Towers, Bangalore-560001.
- Employed candidates have to apply online in the prescribed application form with no objection Certificate from their respective Departments/ Institutions/ companies
- 3. The candidates will be selected in pursuance of the guidelines followed by an interview by the selection Committee.
- 4. And after selection the list approved by the Minority Welfare Department.
- 5. Selection or rejection of any candidate on the basis of various grounds can't be considered as precedence for present or futures years of candidates selections

One Child in The Family and One Time Award

Not more than one child of the same parent/Guardian will be eligible, to this effect a self declaration will be required from the candidate. The selected candidates are not eligible to get this benefit again. This benefit is only once in their study period.

Change of University by the Candidate

Change of University if any by the candidate after counselling by selection committee will not be considered / entertained, after approval list by the Government
